

- 1. Place a DVD or CD into the PC's disk drive
- 2. Look for this shortcut on the PC's desktop

This is the VLC start icon. Double-click on it to open VLC



3. NOTE: If you don't see the VLC shortcut on the PC's desktop, go to Start, then select All Programs
