


Foxit Reader is the Default PDF Reader on All College PCs


Foxit Reader is the default PDF reader on all college PCs including office, classroom, and lab PCs.

Hacker exploitation of PDF files is currently one of the greatest threats on the Internet. **Foxit Reader** is used as the default PDF reader to provide additional security when downloading and viewing PDF files.


When you download a PDF file or open a PDF file on a college PC, the file will open in Foxit Reader, see below:




If the document you are reading has links, is a fillable form or contains active content (such as videos), you may receive a "Security Block" message stating that you need to disable safe reading mode in Trust Manager.




To disable safe reading mode, select:
Edit > Preferences > Trust Manager, and uncheck the box next to "Enable Safe Reading Mode", then click "OK".




NOTE: In addition to disabling Safe Reading Mode, make sure that you select the **Hand selection tool** at the top of the Foxit window:



NOTE: To access Trust Manager while viewing a PDF through Foxit in a web browser, right-click in the PDF file, select the Hand Tool, and then select Page Display Preferences, then the Preferences window will open.



NOTE: If another PDF program such as Adobe Acrobat is installed on your PC and you want to open a PDF on your PC or on a USB drive in that program, **right-click** on the PDF file's name, select **Open with**, and then **select the PDF program that you wish to open it with**. See below:
